Quarterly Update

The West Virginia Offices of the Insurance Commissioner will be providing a quarterly update highlighting the status and key points of the SAWC workers' compensation policy written by Zurich Insurance Company. This is the summary outlining the 2nd quarter policy activity.

-  There are currently 106 agencies/boards/commissions included on the policy. These participants have over 840 locations across the state.
-  The WVOIC has developed a webpage that includes claims manuals, policy information and important notices. The webpage is: <http://www.wvinsurance.gov/SAWC.aspx>
-  SAWC forms have been developed and distributed to contacts. All forms are located on the above webpage. The Employee Brochure has been revised and is available on the SAWC website.
-  The BrickStreet policy (July – September 2011) audits have been completed and the audit results are being finalized. Audit adjustments will be included on your next invoice. July 2012 invoice information is currently being reviewed and you should expect to receive it mid-June.
-  Safety inspections have begun and most agencies have completed their assessments. Zurich and A.J. Gallagher are conducting the inspections.
-  The WVOIC maintains and updates contact and location information. If any changes are made, please notify us.
-  Reminder: Please report all claims within **24 hours** of notification but no later than 5 business days. Please encourage injured employees to use a provider within our CompNet managed health plan.
