**IN THE MATTER OF: Proclamation by Governor Jim Justice dated
August 29, 2017 Extending the State of Emergency Proclaimed on
July 29, 2017**

AMENDED EMERGENCY ADJUSTER ORDER

NOW COMES ALLAN L. MCVEY, Insurance Commissioner for the State of West Virginia (hereinafter “Commissioner”), by virtue of the authority vested in him pursuant to West Virginia Code Section 33-12B-11a, who does **FIND and DECLARE** as follows:

WHEREAS, on the twenty-ninth day of July, two thousand seventeen Governor Jim Justice entered a Proclamation of State of Emergency for Harrison, Marion, Marshall, Monongalia, Ohio, Taylor, Tucker and Wetzel Counties, West Virginia following a severe storm event beginning on the twenty-eighth day of July, two thousand seventeen containing significant rainfall and wind causing rockslides, mudslides and flooding, and damaged homes, businesses, roads and bridges; and

WHEREAS, on the second day of August, two thousand seventeen, the Commissioner entered Emergency Adjuster Order 17-EO-02 as a result of the severe storm event beginning on the twenty-eighth day of July, two thousand seventeen and the Proclamation of State of Emergency entered by Governor Jim Justice on the twenty-ninth day of July, two thousand seventeen; and


WHEREAS, on the seventh day of August, two thousand seventeen, Governor Jim Justice entered a Proclamation declaring that the State of Emergency proclaimed on the twenty-ninth day of July, two thousand seventeen shall be expanded to include Doddridge, Preston and Randolph Counties, West Virginia in addition to Harrison, Marion, Marshall, Monongalia, Ohio, Taylor, Tucker and Wetzel Counties, West Virginia; and

WHEREAS, on the tenth day of August, two thousand seventeen, the Commissioner entered Amended Emergency Adjuster Order 17-EO-02A to amend Emergency Adjuster Order 17-EO-02 entered by the Commissioner on the second day of August, two thousand seventeen to include Doddridge, Preston and Randolph Counties, West Virginia in addition to Harrison, Marion, Marshall, Monongalia, Ohio, Taylor, Tucker and Wetzel Counties, West Virginia; and

WHEREAS, on the twenty-ninth day of August, two thousand seventeen, Governor Jim Justice entered a Proclamation declaring that emergency conditions still exist in the counties of Doddridge, Harrison, Marion, Marshall, Monongalia, Ohio, Preston, Randolph, Taylor, Tucker and Wetzel, and that the State of Emergency proclaimed on the twenty-ninth day of July, two thousand seventeen shall be extended in said counties to remain in effect for thirty days unless terminated by subsequent Proclamation.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Emergency Adjuster Order 17-EO-02 entered by the Commissioner on the second day of August, two thousand seventeen and Amended Emergency Adjuster Order 17-EO-02A entered by the Commissioner on the tenth day of August, two thousand seventeen shall be amended to extend the ninety (90) day registration period set forth therein to one hundred twenty (120) days.
