NIPR mobile application can now be downloaded for free

In a continuous effort to simplify producer licensing, NIPR (national insurance producer registry) has introduced the NIPR mobile app. The NIPR mobile app allows insurance professionals, licensed by the West Virginia Offices of the Insurance Commissioner, to view their basic licensing information, such as license numbers, expiration dates, lines of authority and appointment information. Insurance professionals now have all their licensing information at their fingertips!

Why does this benefit the insurance producer?

1. It's FREE!
2. Access to licensing information 24/7
3. Producers can now manage the life cycle of their licenses with the ease of license renewal notifications.
4. The app is safe and secure.
5. Producers will have their most up-to-date licensing information each day.
6. When carriers/agencies request licensing information from a producer, it is readily available to the producer.
7. When selling/soliciting products, they have proof of licensure should a consumer request the information.

New features include,

The newly released license renewal reminder will allow for notifications of an upcoming license expiration. This will give producers plenty of time to complete their renewals and meet continuing education requirements.

The new appointment information feature will allow producers to see their company appointments, termination date(s) and effective date(s).

Any professional licensed by a state insurance department can use the app to view their basic licensing information – which includes license numbers, expiration dates and lines of authority – in addition to the new features.
