

Commissioner Dodrill Selected as 2021 West Virginia Bar Foundation Fellow

Commissioner Dodrill has been selected as a member of the 2021 class of West Virginia Bar Foundation Fellows. Those selected as Fellows are judges and lawyers whose professional, public, and private careers have demonstrated outstanding dedication to the welfare of their communities and honorable service to the legal profession with the individuals selected reflecting the diverse nature of the legal profession in West Virginia. Approximately 400 individuals have received this high honor out of more than 6,000 judges and lawyers in the state of West Virginia. The Fellows have joint activities with the state's members of the American Bar Foundation Fellows, since most ABF Fellows are also WV Bar Foundation Fellows.

The primary mission of the West Virginia Bar Foundation is to make grants to organizations that provide legal services to low-income citizens and that improve the administration of justice, including the Public Service Scholarship to a worthy student at the West Virginia University College of Law. More than \$510,000 has been distributed and committed since the first grant in 2004, with approximately one half million dollars occurring in just the past 12 years.
