Bradley A. Crouser Appointed as Chief Administrative Law Judge

On September 18, 2019, Governor Justice appointed Charleston attorney Bradley A. Crouser Chief Administrative Law Judge of the Workers Compensation Office of Judges within the Offices of the Insurance Commissioner. His four-year term begins December 2, 2019.

Crouser is a graduate of the WVU College of Law. He has served as a Marion County Magistrate, Deputy Commissioner of the West Virginia Department of Finance and Administration, was Executive Secretary of the West Virginia Workers Compensation Fund, and was Tax Commissioner of West Virginia. In private practice his primary area of concentration was workers compensation and federal black lung litigation. Most recently he served as Staff Attorney for Supreme Court of Appeals Justice Tim Armstead.
