



## *Licensing & Education Division*

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**Resident/Nonresident business entities:** corporations, partnerships, limited liability companies, limited liability partnerships

Every business entity must designate at least one individual principal insurance producer who holds a West Virginia insurance producer license and who will be responsible for the business entity's compliance with the insurance laws, rules and regulations in this state.

In West Virginia, business entities are not licensed according to lines of authority.

**The business entity should also contact the [West Virginia Secretary of State](#) (304-558-6000) to ensure compliance with West Virginia corporate law.**

Regardless of when issued, a West Virginia resident business entity license renews annually on June 30th.

Any changes to the officers, director, or address change must be reported within 10 days.

The fee for an initial application and for each renewal \$200.
