Types of Licenses (Resident)

The West Virginia Insurance Commission grants the following types of licenses:

Licenses Requiring an Examination

Life	Company Adjuster
Accident & Health or Sickness	Public Adjuster
Property*	Independent Adjuster
Casualty*	Professional Bail Bonds
Personal Lines	Surety Bail Bonds
Viatical Settlement Broker	Crop****
Surplus Lines**	Variable Annuity***

Licenses Not Requiring an Examination

Car Rental	Travel
Credit	Business Entity
Surety	Travel Insurance Business Entity
Title	Self Storage

Types of Licenses (Nonresident)

The West Virginia Insurance Commission grants the following types of licenses *above* to nonresidents as well. A nonresident license is issued based upon the applicant's license authority in the state of residence.

*May be taken as individual examinations or combined (Property and Casualty)

** Must hold a Property & Casualty license for three consecutive years

***Variable annuity producers must have a FINRA registration. No separate exam is required.

****For Residents applying for a Crop Adjuster license, the Commissioner may accept certification that the individual has passed a proficiency examination approved by the Federal Risk Management Agency.
